The 2017 membership cycle will end on 15<sup>th</sup> August. I would like to highlight the stage for the membership figures in Region 10. Although we are pulled down by the Higher Grade Member (excluding the Graduate Students) recruitment, the overall membership number still stands at a respectable -0.2% compared to the same month last year. This is attributed to the significant increase in student recruitment, with total Undergraduates number jumping to 11.9% from 1.7% last month and that of the Graduate students maintaining at a solid 4.5%. I would also reiterate the solid performance by R10 WIE with membership growth of 19% y-o-y and 11% for R10 YP affinity group.

However, the Undergraduate retention paints a dismal figure, with only 28.5% renewing their student memberships. I would like to request for the Section leaders to work with their student branches to engage the students, and send a reminder to them to renew their student memberships. In addition, most student elevations to full members will take place from June to August. It will be good to remind them of the 50% reduction in 1<sup>st</sup> year full member dues. This is a critical moment in their memberships. We have to act fast as we only have less than half a month before the end of this membership year.

Let us endeavor to achieve positive growth in membership for Region 10. Last year, we achieved a 2% increase in membership in this final stretch. With your effort and support, I am sure we can do it once again for the current membership year.

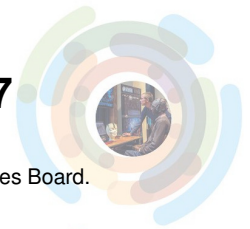

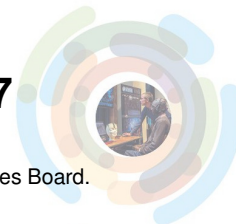

## 2017 Membership Development Goals

MD goals are created for each individual Section for both recruitment and retention. Section goals are then rolled up to the Region level, producing the Region goal for recruitment, retention and overall membership.

For the 2017 MD goals, we reviewed five years of history. Each Section has a unique goal based on different dynamics, so the methodology for creating the goal is different based on whether the Section has had growth or decline, as well as the overall size and location of the Section.

Goals do not separate HG versus student. A benefit of this is that the service deactivation and student elevation processes do not impact progress to goals, because it focuses only on the total number of members that join or renew (regardless of grade). Goals for reinstatement are assigned on the Region level only. For the complete listing of Section goals, visit the MD goals page on the MD portal, [www.ieee.org/md](http://www.ieee.org/md).

Each Section that meets their goal receives a special recognition in the form of an electronic banner that can be placed on Section websites, in newsletters, and even in e-mail signatures. Banners are distributed to the Section's Membership Development Chair, and/or Section Chair, and include the membership year and Section name in the graphic. A silver award will be given in either the recruitment or retention category once met. A gold medal of recognition will be given once both goals are met.

At the end of the year, a special gift and certificate of recognition will be mailed to those who earned the gold award. Certificates of recognition will also be mailed to those who earned either silver award.



Congratulations to the five Sections that met both their recruitment and retention goals so far this year. Keep up the great work!

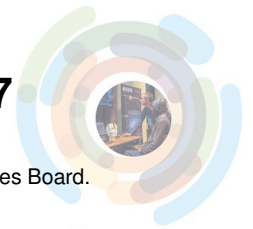
